### **Director's Report**

- -County will re-assess Library 2018 budget request Tuesday November 28th. Because it is more than 5%, County may pass or send it back to City Council for consideration.
- -Patsy Ingebrigtsen retires from the Children's Librarian position on Thursday, Nov. 30. Erika Ternes has been making good progress in training as her replacement.
- -Friday night reels information has gone to ALS.
- -Winter Series schedule is almost complete. First event will be "Roots of Pushing Chain"
- -5 star Library designation to be announced in December. If Grand Marais gets it, it will be our 10th year in a row, a special designation.
- -Readers and writers festival had strong participation. Final numbers are being worked out.
- -Harsin passed along a Mail-A-Book press release from ALS. Grand Marais is helping Arrowhead Library System to promote this service.
- -Costs for 2017 Strategic Plan were consistent with expectations. Consultant donated \$2698.06 in work time beyond the contract. Total direct expenses for the process came to \$9330.58
- -Harsin updated Board as to impacts of 2017 (to date) Library operations on 215 fund. Due to donations, grants, reimbursements, and interest payments, the deduction from the 215 was modest. \*Comment was made asking whether the Library solicits donations. Answer: The Library makes it easy to donate via form located on website, but does not actively solicit.

## **Library Friends report:**

-Board meeting a few week ago with election of officers. Friends Board is still at 9 members. Will have a retreat to discuss book storage and strategy for the future. Friends cashed in CDs to make available assets for grants that they offer. They are looking actively for another space to store donated books.

- Financial Committee: County budget hearing scheduled for 11/28.
- Policy Committee: No report.
- Personnel Committee: Meeting in December to do annual review for Director. Date to be decided.
- Art Committee: No report.
- Legacy Art Committee: Progress report. Jay, Steve

\*Johnson moved to ask city to revoke current contract with Skadberg Masonry and demand return of Poetry Walk molds. Second: Danfelt. Motion passed with one abstention.

    -December 24<sup>th</sup> is on a Monday. It is left to Director discretion to decide closer to the holiday whether to close the library that day.
